Most degree programs have a Fall, Spring, and Summer semester with the exception of Master of Organizational Leadership (MOL) and Master of Business Administration (MBA) will Fall and Spring semesters. The guide helps to show how financial aid packages may be recalculated by adding or dropping courses in a semester.
